Who is eligible?

Free registration will be awarded with preference to these categories:

- Municipal employees (e.g., city/town administrator/manager, emergency preparedness personnel, public works personnel, planning staff, parks and recreation staff, code and zoning personnel)
- Elected or appointed municipal decision-makers (e.g., mayor; city/town-councilor; selectboard member; members of zoning board of appeals, planning board, conservation commission, and historic district commission)
- County government employees
- Regional planning council personnel (council of governments; regional planning and development agencies)

How will the funding be awarded?

Applications will be reviewed and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, until all the funding has been awarded. Funds will be provided *after* the conference based on the provision of a receipt for conference registration. Those awarded will be provided a reimbursement form to be used for accessing the award. The deadline for submission of the reimbursement form and registration receipt is May 13, 2016.
